

**Information about the workshop week of Techniques of Drawing and Space
Representation 1.
(14-18 of September 2026)**

The workshop starts on **14 of September, at 9:00 a.m.** in the Ceremonial Hall (Díszterem) where the group schedule will be announced.

Drawing lessons last from 9:00 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 3:45 p.m.

Some of the tasks will be prepared on worksheets which have a cost 500 forints that has to be paid during the workshop week.

Drawing tools that must be brought:

- black felt-tip pens of 2-3 different thicknesses (Signo, Stabilo, Stadler, Faber Castell),
- 1 thicker felt-tip pen with a soft tip (size 0.5 or thicker)
- 1 A4 size drawing board, it can also be a folder on which you will draw, (it should not be heavy)
- drawing board for sitting area, (we have got only 15 fishing chairs) so anyone who has such a light chair at home can bring it with them, we can store it in the drawing studio during the week, you don't have to bring it with you every day,
- Weather-appropriate clothing,
- 1 A2 size drawing board with an A2 size folder,
- 1 2B graphite pencil,
- 1 3B graphite pencil,
- 10 pieces A2 size drawing sheets,
- 1 eraser and 1 kneadable eraser,
- drawing pins, pencil sharpener, sharpening knife
- optional: colored felt-tip pens, colored pencils.
