

Specialisation Application Results

Landscape Architecture and Landscape Planning Bachelor's Programme (BSc)

Spring 2026

In accordance with the Specialisation Application Guidelines, the applications submitted for specialisation were evaluated by the Programme Director and the Deputy Director for Education of the Institute. Based on the evaluation, applicants were ranked according to their academic performance and portfolio assessment.

Scoring

Applicants could obtain a maximum of:

- **8.00 points** based on the credit-weighted grade point average of the compulsory courses completed during the first three semesters;
- **12.00 points** based on the average grades achieved in the weighted and highly weighted courses;
- **20.00 points** based on the portfolio.

The maximum total score was **40.00 points**.

The results are presented in the table below.

Based on the above results, the decisions regarding the applications submitted through the NEPTUN system will be recorded by the staff of the Directorate of Education. Subsequently, the staff of the Buda Campus Registrar's Office will assign each student to the corresponding specialisation curriculum in the NEPTUN system.
